1. Are SLPs and SLPAs able to provide speech and language services?

Yes. SLPAs may provide speech and language services as long as they are supervised by an SLP.

2. What are the responsibilities of the Lead School Psychologist in regards to the SELPA application process?

If and when the school applies for membership in a SELPA, the Lead School Psychologist will assist in the gathering of information for the application and the drafting of the application.

3. Are school counselors with PPS credentials able to provide the support outlined in the Mental Health Specialist's scope of work?

No, we require a School Psychologist or Mental Health Specialist with experience in conducting psychological assessments, designing/planning and implementing behavior intervention, and conducting parent counseling and training for parents to provide those particular services described in the scope of work.
